



For Families Selecting GREEN CEMETERIES:

Busch Funeral and Crematory Services makes available several “green” burial options and is one of a select group of funeral providers certified by the Green Burial Council, a nonprofit organization that encourages the use of burial as a means of facilitating the restoration, acquisition, and stewardship of natural areas throughout the United States. For such arrangements, formaldehyde-based embalming is prohibited as is the use of metal or concrete grave liners, burial vaults, or other permanent burial containers. Caskets, coffins or alternative containers used to enclose and transport the dead are made of biodegradable materials and are available in a range of prices. Home wakes, public visitations, church funerals and graveside services are options that may be arranged within the limited time frame green burial allows. As with all of our service and merchandise offerings, detailed price information for each component is itemized on our schedule of Services and Fees, the General Price List, the Casket Price List and the Biodegradable Containers Price List.

Green cemetery options allow families to select a green burial or a green cremation. Many families will have a gathering formal or informal prior to or after the green committal. This allows a time of remembrance for family and friends to come together prior to the green committal.

A green burial may require the assistance of a funeral home approved by the Green Burial Council. Busch Funeral and Crematory Services is the only approved funeral home in Northeast Ohio. We comply with the code that no formaldehyde-based embalming will occur and the use of only biodegradable caskets and biodegradable urns will be made available for use in green cemeteries. Our professionals can discuss your options with you based upon service preferences.

Meaningful Memorialization – Ways to Personalize A Service

Why should Busch Funeral and Crematory Services assist with your ceremony?

The survivors usually have so many things to cope with that our presence removes what could otherwise be a large burden to organize and oversee something so important. When one considers the importance of the funeral or memorial ceremony, we help to ensure that you, your family, and friends stay focused on each other's needs rather than the many details associated with the service.

We aspire to facilitate a funeral or memorial ceremony that reflects your loved one's beliefs and legacy with dignity and beauty. At the initial arrangement, we provide memory boards to display special photos. We receive flowers that are sent to the church or other facility. We coordinate the musicians and clergy and prepare honorarium checks. We prepare a typed summary for clergy listing various helpful details that pertain to the deceased and survivors as well as the ceremony. We arrive early and attractively display the flowers in accordance with religious customs and clergy preference that may apply. We bring, and display, or otherwise care for the casket or cremated remains as you so desire. We transfer and display flowers, memory boards, and any mementos as you direct us. We reserve and assist with seating. We greet people as they enter and offer any printed goods such as a memorial folder. We set up the memorial register for signatures. We are able to assist with the playing of pre-recorded music during the ceremony if applicable.

Celebrant

Busch Certified Funeral Celebrants have been specifically trained to design and conduct a personalized Life Tribute that honors your beliefs and the legacy of your loved one. After establishing the mutually agreed upon time and place for the service our celebrant will meet with family members, record stories, and discuss the elements you wish to include in the service. Families have been extremely pleased with choosing from the following options:

- **Full Life Tribute** begins with Family Meeting 1-2 hours to record stories and capture the essence of your loved one. You may choose the item you desire, however, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain to you the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Service for Funeral Director and Staff

\$2,062

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation of death and obituary notices and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, recordkeeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. You may select private family viewing with or without embalming, and service or ceremony.

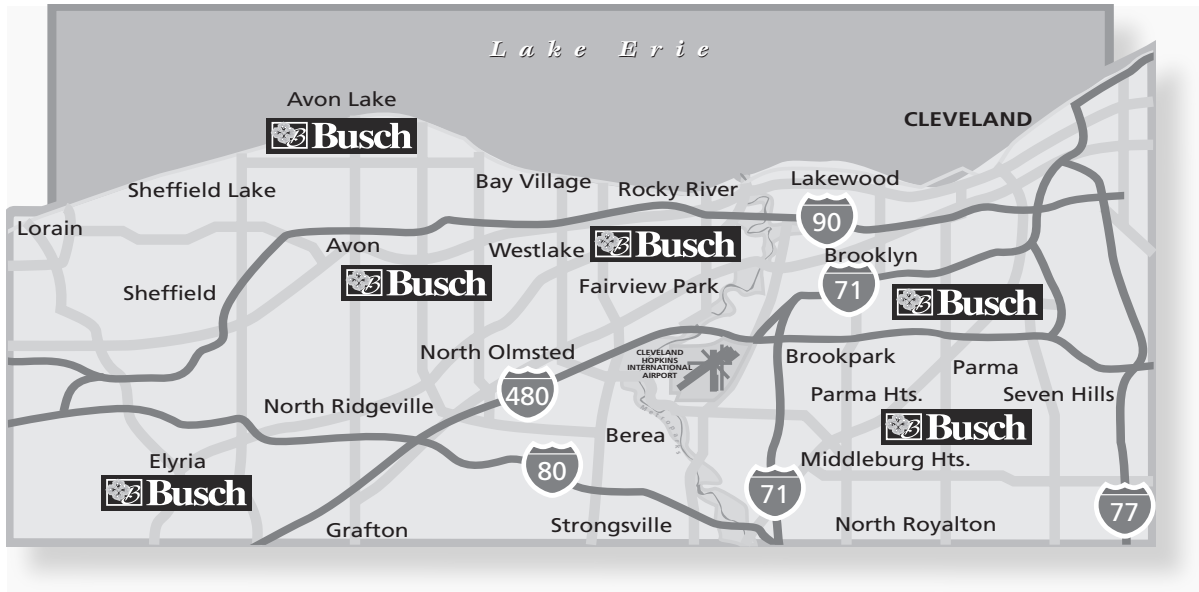
